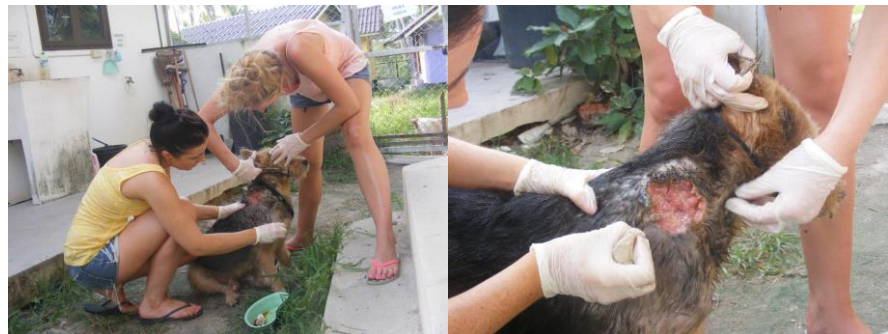
October 14th 2014
